FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

When we hear the words, "Standing in unity and in solidarity" what comes to your mind? I have pondered this thought over and over again in my mind. Most recently, with the unrest on college campuses and protests in the streets of many cities across our nation and the world surrounding the Jewish/Palestinian conflict, I sometimes wonder what the phrase means.

As a Pastor who has close relationships with Jews and Palestinians my heart bleeds when I look at the devastation of hundreds of hostages being held by Hamas, but at the same time, I feel the pain for those who have been killed by the bombs coming from Israel. I have compassion for these innocent lives that are being lost on both sides. The reality is, while I have deep love for my Jewish brothers and sisters, I implore the Israeli government to stop the rampage of killing the Palestinian civilians. For Palestine, I ask that they dismantle Hamas and return Israeli hostages who have been held captive. This does not mean that I have abandoned my Jewish friends nor have I disavowed my relationship with my Palestinian friends and comrades. I would have been surprised if Israel did not retaliate after having been bombed in a surprise attack on October 7, 2023; however, it appears that the Israeli government wants to totally annihilate the Palestinians. Palestinians have a right to exist and prosper just as much as anyone else. In essence, what happened to the Jews by the Germans in World War II, seems to be the aim of Benjamin Netanyahu to the Palestinians and America is caught up in the middle!

It is my belief that agreements can only come when both sides agree to a cease fire. Both sides are hurting. Both sides have suffered losses and both sides are spending millions upon millions of dollars to continue fighting which is destroying the economy and killing innocent lives on both ends.

I am asking the people of God to pray for a cease fire so that fruitful discussions might occur that will benefit both sides. Moreover, I believe that believers can stand in unity and solidarity with Jews and Palestinians because as we stand together, we demonstrate a spirit of compassion for those who have suffered loss of family and friends. My love and respect for people of the Jewish faith does not diminish my love for the people of Palestine. Both sides must stop fighting and both sides must agree to place human life above any political or economic agenda.

Together let us pray for peace.
